**Minimum entries:** For each class is 6. Classes not subscribed by close of entries (Wednesday prior to the meeting) may be cancelled and monies refunded.

Late entries will be accepted up to last post on the Friday prior to the event on subscribed classes only and may be put rear of field for first two (2) heats. **No entries will be accepted on the day of competition.**

**If a class does not run at any round of this series, IT WILL NOT BE OFFERED AGAIN**

**THROUGHOUT Super4Series 2010.** (Sportsman 100 Light, Heavy and Sportsman Super Heavy are no longer eligible)

## Notes:

- Track is licensed for 32 karts.
- **Classes will be run co-jointly according subject to track licensing restrictions and where practical and possible.**

**Super4Series 2010 RULES:** Class must run four times to be eligible for overall prizes/trophies. Drivers must enter and race four times to be eligible for overall prizes/trophies. All points count. Winner is highest point scorer of the day for class at each meeting. Winner of series is highest points overall for class in series.

NOTE: SPORTSMAN LIGHT, SPORTSMAN HEAVY AND SPORTSMAN SUPER HEAVY ARE NO LONGER ELIGIBLE FOR THIS SERIES.

### **SPECIAL NOTES:**

- Head sealing nuts must be fitted to engines as per rule 19.33. If engine seals are issued, competitor is to fit them, but must leave the tail at full length. Tyres may be marked.
- Drivers should have a clear visor available to use if/when Stewards deem it necessary.
- Restrictors (Midgets/Rookies) may be sealed. Must have nuts fitted on exhaust as per AKA Karting Manual 2010
- No dogs, no skateboards, no bicycles, no bad manners at circuit at all. No smoking, no alcohol in pit area/s at any given time.
- Please observe designated smoking areas at all times.
- Rotax entrants should consult suggested websites for further information.
- Leopard entrants should consult suggested websites for further information.
- Unlicensed drivers are NEVER permitted to move vehicles around circuits at Tiger Kart Club.
