**SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS**

*The meeting will be held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the General Karting Regulations of the AKA and any further addendums and bulletins to the regulations.*

**PERMIT NUMBER : 24/2011**

**ELIGIBLE CLASSES :** *Midgets, Rookies, Junior National Combined @ 130 kg, Senior National Combined @ 150 kg, Sportsman 100 Nearly Light @ 150 kg, Sportsman 100 Very Heavy @ 170 kg, Restricted 125 Combined @ 175 kg, Sportsman 125 Combined @ 175 kg*

**RACE FORMAT : THIS IS A BIT UNUSUAL SO TAKE NOTE !!**

*All racing will be in a clockwise direction.*

*Heat 1 – Ballot , 840 mtrs , 12 laps*

*Heat 2 – Reverse ballot , 750 mtrs , 16 laps*

*Final – Highest points to front , 480 mtrs ( Tri-oval ) , 20 laps*

*289 points system, all points count. Highest points on day is winner for day.*

**MINIMUM ENTRIES :** *for each class is 6. Classes not subscribed by close of entries may be cancelled and monies refunded.*

**TRACK DENSITY :** *for Wanneroo circuit is 24*

**ENTRY FEES :** *Seniors: \$40.00 for first entry , \$20.00 for subsequent entries.  
Juniors , Rookies , Midgets : \$30.00*

**PRIZES :** **There will be NO TROPHIES OR CASH PRIZES for place getters. Random draws will be done throughout the day for prizes. Everyone has a chance to win something.**

**CLOSE OF ENTRIES :** *Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> of November 2011. NO ENTRIES accepted on the day.*

*Pre entries preferred. An entry is **NOT VALID** until payment has been received.*

*EFT entries must include a payment advice showing Surname and License number otherwise Lin has a nightmare trying to trace what money has come from where.*

**SPECIAL NOTES :**

- This is designed to be a FUN meeting, but we still must comply with AKA regulations.
- Transponders compulsory ( just like a normal race meeting )
- People wishing to “Have a Go” in a friends or relatives kart, must sign an insurance indemnity form and comply with ALL AKA regulations regarding this. Juniors can only use karts with a Yamaha J engine and Seniors can only use karts with Yamaha J or S engines or RESTRICTED 125 engines.
- The 1<sup>st</sup> round ONLY will include a combined Midget / Rookie race for P Platers only.
- Drivers are not permitted on track to practice until they have completed driver registration and scrutineering.
- P Plate drivers MUST be scrutineered by an official.
- Sportsman 100 classes to run as per WA State Rules 2011, and relevant chapters of AKA Karting Manual 2011 (refer to Chapters 34 & 36) W/C cooled entrants to run at 5 kg heavier than A/C. (Note: Kart weight increases accordingly for W/C entrants).
- Sportsman 125 classes to use MG Reds ONLY.
- Kart numbers must conform to Rule 25.17 – this includes numbers on side pods. Failure to conform will result in not getting through scrutineering and /or not being lap scored correctly.
- Head sealing nuts must be fitted to engines as per rule 19.33. When engine seals are issued, competitor is to fit them, but must leave the tail at full length.
- CHECK YOUR HELMET: DOES IT CONFORM TO CURRENT RULES? (i.e. is it less than 10 years old ? )
- Restrictors (**Midgets/Rookies**) may be sealed. Must have nut fitted on exhaust.
- No dogs, no skateboards, no bicycles, no bad manners at circuit at all. No smoking , no alcohol in pit areas at any given time.
